As with every church and ministry around the world, we were deeply impacted by the COVID pandemic. Many training groups could not meet for in-person training. Schedules were upended on a moment's notice. Many church members suddenly lost their livelihoods due to lock-downs. In place of regular worship, leaders were engaged in distribution of food or attending to other crises.

Several TLT trainers or family members passed away due to COVID. We honor Dr. EMMANUEL JOHNSON from Liberia. Before his death he served as the president of Day Springs Bible College where placed TLT into the curriculum of the college.



We honor Mrs. MALENA QUIROGA, the wife of Rev. Martin Nevelef, TLT trainer in Ecuador. We pray for the peace and comfort of Christ to be with her family and church community.

brought TLT to Cuzco, high in the mountains of Peru. Pastor BENJAMIN HUAPAYA was a High School teacher and pastor, and was among the first TLT graduates in Peru. Pastor HENRY OLORTEGUI, also among the first TLT graduates, was a dedicated trainer in several places.



And finally, we honor Mrs. MARY CHAMA of Zambia. She served as an elder, preacher, and teacher. With a vision for TLT beyond Zambia, she was a pioneer in establishing TLT in the Democratic Republic of Congo in 2018.

Through all of these challenges, and through mourning, God has been faithful. TLT training groups unfailingly surrounded each other with love and support.

TLT training activities slowed down, but they did not stop. Many groups held training outdoors, with lots of fresh air and yes, sometimes rain showers, wind, or honking horns. Several groups offered online training, notwithstanding the challenges of internet reliability. “I’ll see you on Zoom” became a common invitation to meet together.



TLT also formatted videos for mobile phones. The video courses “Loving your Neighbor in the COVID-19 Pandemic” and “God’s Unfailing Love” were a great encouragement to many leaders around the world. Through all the challenges, TLT continued to be a vital resource for training global church leaders. Thank you for your generous financial support, notes, and prayers.

We have many plans in the works! We are revising our seven core manuals and translating them into 30-plus languages. Our newest manual, “Fear Not: A Christian Attitude About Spiritual Powers”, will be released in 2022. We are developing new video courses for mobile phones. And we continue to engage new ministry partners around the world who find that TLT is just what they were looking for!
